

## EDITORIAL

Dear People of Montmaurin,

Following a comprehensive review of the state of village buildings and their needs, in order to maintain them we need to plan for renovation work. This **programme is planned over several years** in order to:

- . Prevent water infiltrating the roofs, particularly by renovation of the roof structure of the Notre-Dame de la Hillière chapel, the Maison Peyre and the village hall,
- . Allow electricity production through the installation of solar panels to the roofs of the Maison Peyre and the village hall,
- . Restore the stained glass window in the Chapel de ND,
- . Bring the electrical installations and safety measures in the buildings used for the Mairie and the Museum up to required standards and to plan to change the door and window frames,
- . Make the various buildings and surroundings accessible to those with reduced mobility.

Various small improvement and repair works must be added to this.

All this will be carried forward once we know what subsidies we will be given, allowing us to schedule these renovations in which Daniel Morandin (our village employee) helped by volunteers who want to bring life to our village, will participate.

Studies are underway for the renovation of the paddling pool ( the small pool at the swimming pool), renovation of public lighting in order to make savings on electricity, installing signs at the entrances to the village giving early information for visitors on the existing infrastructure (camp site, swimming pool, museum, Gallo-Roman villa ...).

The following work has been carried out recently:

- . The enlarging of the village columbarium,
- . Direct access to the swimming pool to allow the Fire and Safety Department to use the main pool as an emergency water supply.

These are days of promise for the future of MONTMAURIN.

## First Aid information and use of the defibrillator

Didier TERRAIL, trainer in health and safety at work, is offering an introduction to first aid and to the use of the defibrillator on

This is not training in the use of the defibrillator equipment. Following this session, it will be possible to arrange training leading to certification for those interested. Further details will be given later.

## Young people from the age of 16 years

All people, whether boy or girl, of French nationality must be registered between the date of their 16th birthday and the end of the third month following this. Having been registered, it is obligatory to complete a JDC (**day of defence and citizenship**), formerly called the Day of registration for preparation in defence.(JAPD).
